



STRATEGY TIPS

Legend Raiders is a game suitable both for families and expert players.

It's simple to learn, but offers different tactical and strategic possibilities. In this pages are some tips for your games, with different strategies you can use.

In the end, Legend Raiders wants to be **a simple resource management game**, appropriate as an entry level game both for children and adults: use and mix different strategies the way they suit you best and find your perfect balance.



STRATEGY TIP 1



You can focus on **COLLECTING** as many Discoveries as possible before performing them.

If you plan and collect 3 Discoveries on your board before completing them you can quickly rush to the end of the game. Each Discovery will give you less points, but you will complete Discoveries faster than other players!

LESS POINTS > QUICKER END



STRATEGY TIP 2

You can perform 1 Discovery at a time and **MAXIMIZE** your **VICTORY POINTS**.

If you focus on completing one Discovery per turn you maximize your points (and get more Mission cards); **Discoveries will be more difficult to complete** because you will need to take new Discovery tiles **based on the associated Tools** and not based on your Mission cards.

CHOOSE carefully your **TOOLS**



STRATEGY TIP 3



You can focus on MISSION CARDS.

Choose carefully new Discovery tiles based on your Mission cards, **even when they're not associated with the Tools** you actually need to complete them.

**Choose the DISCOVERY,
not the TOOLS**

STRATEGY TIP 4

You can focus on DISCOVERING PLACES.

Discovering Places allows you to score **more points later**, but it's **more expensive** than discovering Relics. Moreover, Mission cards with Places grant less points.



STRATEGY TIP 5




You can focus on **DISCOVERING RELICS.**

Discovering only Relics allows you to try to accomplish **more Mission cards**, but consider that **each Relic is rarer** than Places, so they can be tricky to collect especially in a 4-player games!

STRATEGY TIP 6

You can focus on using your Favorite Tool.

Choose new Discovery tiles that require your favorite Tool, even when they are associated with unuseful Tools. **It's a bit risky** but it can earn you **extra points**.



STRATEGY TIP 7

Do you prefer a direct challenge with others?

It is possible to play in an aggressive mode, by trying to take the tiles or the Mission cards that can be useful to other players; this tactic can be especially useful in a 2-player game.

Make the most of the Die card.

The Die card can be powerful if used at the right moment; of course taking this card also means taking one less Mission card.
